


# BLOOD IN YOUR URINE?

## Discussion Guide

You may be worried if you see blood in your urine. Don't ignore it as it can indicate various health concerns, including possible bladder cancer. Use the chart below to help you work out your next steps.



**Hematuria**  
he-ma-tu-ria  
The presence of blood or blood cells in the urine

**Blood is visible** = macrohematuria  
**Blood is not visible** = microhematuria (diagnosed by dipstick or urinalysis)

## Signs & Symptoms Of Bladder Cancer

**I have experienced one or more of the following signs and symptoms:**

- Blood in my urine
- Painful urination
- The urgent need to urinate
- Needing (but not being able) to urinate
- Abdominal pain
- Fatigue
- Lower back pain
- Appetite or weight loss

- What are the options available to me?
- Which of these options are invasive?
- Which are non-invasive?
- Are there any risks or side effects associated with any of these diagnostic tests?

- How long do I have to wait?
- What happens if I am found to have bladder cancer?
- Can you explain my treatment options?
- Why is it important to detect bladder cancer early?
